home is where my mom brought me up with him and my grandmother who described me lovingly as such a curious little guy This book was written for the undiagnosed or recently diagnosed adult hoping to add a little order into the disorder I wanted to have some fun so I won t quote the DSM not even on accident I will however quote TED talks YouTube Videos and blogs This shouldn t feel like a depressing sludge through the mush if it does I didn t do my job This should feel like coming home without all the stress of actually having to go home Thousands and thousands of years of humans have evolved to make you How could you possibly be a mistake My wife loves me like crazy and I love her She is neurotypical and I am autistic I would have had a terribly difficult time getting to know me these past few years without her love and patience I am understood What more could an Aspie ask for I still don t understand all of these weird human beings I live here with completely or their primal relationships but I enjoy them more and more every day that I am lucky enough to get to know them a little better while spending my time here on earth I wish for you love and understanding and maybe a good laugh or two Welcome home
