BEOWULF (Collector's Edition) Anonymous,2017-11-15 Beowulf is the conventional title of an Old English heroic epic poem consisting of 3182 alliterative long lines set in Scandinavia commonly cited as one of the most important works of Anglo Saxon literature It survives in a single manuscript known as the Nowell Codex Its composition by an anonymous Anglo Saxon poet is dated between the 8th and the early 11th century In 1731 the manuscript was badly damaged by a fire that swept through a building housing a collection of Medieval manuscripts assembled by Sir Robert Bruce Cotton The poem s existence for its first seven centuries or so made no impression on writers and scholars and besides a brief mention in a 1705 catalogue by Humfrey Wanley it was not studied until the end of the eighteenth century and not published in its entirety until the 1815 edition prepared by the Icelandic Danish scholar Gr mur J nsson Thorkelin In the poem Beowulf a hero of the Geats in Scandinavia comes to the help of Hro gar the king of the Danes whose mead hall in Heorot has been under attack by a monster known as Grendel After Beowulf slays him Grendel s mother attacks the hall and is then also defeated Victorious Beowulf goes home to Geatland in Sweden and later becomes king of the Geats After a period of fifty years has passed Beowulf defeats a dragon but is fatally wounded in the battle After his death his attendants bury him in a tumulus a burial mound in Geatland The numerous different translations and interpretations of Beowulf turn this monumental work into a challenge for the reader
