X-ray and Dx studies.

What makes up the Secondary Survey? -Answer- AMPLE Hx and Detailed Physical Exam
Mechanism of Injury
Head and Maxillofacial
C-spine
Chest
Abdomen
Perineum/Rectum/Vagina
Musculoskeletal
Neurologic

What is something you could do to get a quick assessment of ABCD? -Answer- Ask the pt. a question. If they can respond it can give you an idea about their airway and mental status. Failure to respond tells you there are abnormalities in ABCD.

What assumption can safely be made in a pt. with blunt multisystem trauma above the clavicle or Altered mental status? -Answer- That the C-spine is compromised.

4 Steps to manage A? -Answer- Assess for patency Establish airway
