
Learning outcomes of the lab exercises:

- Identify and sketch regions of the skin and associated accessory structures such as hair and glands that were observed on the microscope slides.

- SKIN AND ITS TISSUES (Cutaneous Membrane)
 - A. General Structure:
 - Two distinct regions or layers compose the skin:
 - Epidermis = outermost layer;
 - keratinized stratified squamous ET.
 - b. Dermis = inner layer;
 - glandular epithelium (sweat, sebaceous glands),
 - dense irregular CT (collagen),
 - smooth muscle tissue (arrector pili muscles),
 - nervous tissue (Meissner's & Pacinian Corpuscles), and
 - hair follicles and blood vessels
 - Subcutaneous layer = adipose tissue; also called hypodermis
