fashions of their days just as they clothed their bodies in the garments of their times To imitate either their style of expression or their costumes would be to make one s self ridiculous or to take part in a species of masquerade The extremely Latinized vocabulary of 1711 or the resonant periods and marked antitheses of 1850 are as old fashioned to day as are the once highly respected periwigs great coats and silver shoe buckles of the past The thoughts of yesterday are not the thoughts of to day There is in serious reality such a thing as an old fashioned point of view With all due reverence for the past the best teachers of to day believe that it is just as necessary for students to use present day methods of expression and to cultivate present day interests as it is to take advantage of the railroad the telegraph the telephone the automobile and the thousand other mechanical contrivances that aid life to day but which were unknown in 1711 or in 1850
