Despite these numbers, incarcerated women and women lifers specifically represent a relatively small percentage of the overall correctional and lifer populations. As such, women lifers are easy to overlook, discount, and diminish as such a small group. Many women lifers perceive themselves as a forgotten group, most often those whom we lock up and throw away the key.
