Description of the lesson:	In the previous lessons (during the lesson hours of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> unit, approximately 1 week), the teacher taught the simple present continuous tense to students. The students know making sentences using the simple present continuous tense (e.g. Subject + am/is/are + Ving + object t) and some verbs such as swim, talk, walk etc. (e.g. I am swimming, I am walking, etc.) In this lesson, the students don't know adjectives of emotions and feelings (e.g. scared, angry, etc.). They will teach the seven adjectives of feeling and make sentences with them using the simple present continuous tense.	
The Goal:	The main goal of this lesson is to teach adjectives of feelings and the students tell how to feel themselves using adjectives.
