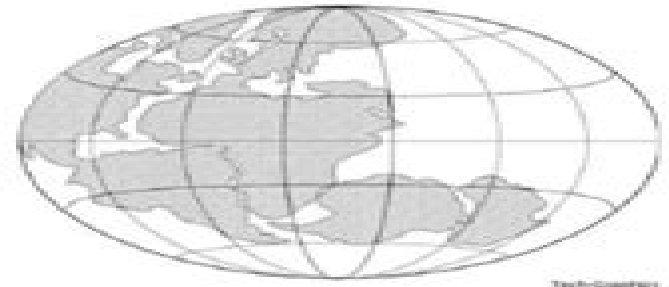
Background
