If needed, you can make comments such as "George could have higher grades, but is frequently off task and requires re-direction from the teacher."

Try and look at the comments through the teacher lens and through a parent lens. Also try to ensure that the comments match the grades. If Melissa has an F in math and your comment states "Melissa foves math and is doing much better now." This would be a mixed massage.
