

- (1) Abraham Lincoln (1809-1865) grew up among the poor people of the Kentucky and Indiana territories. His grandfather, also named Abraham, had crossed the Alleghenies to Kentucky, where he was killed in a conflict with Native Americans. His father Thomas, a carpenter, never learned to read or write. His mother died when Lincoln was nine.
- (2) A year later his father remarried. A kindly widow with three children of her own, Sarah Bush Johnston brought order and warmth into the desolate log cabin by Pigeon Creek in Indiana. With her encouragement, Abraham learned to read and write and do arithmetic. After a day's work in the woods, the boy would lie on the floor and study the few worn books which were his best possessions.
- (3) At 16, young Abe was already known for his strength, his gift of speech, his jokes, and his funny stories. A tall, dark, angular youth, by the age of 18

he was six feet four inches tall and weighed nearly two hundred pounds.

- Eventually, the family pulled up and left to Illinois. Young Lincoln drove the family wagon with a team of oxen along the rough frontier roads. At 21, he left his father's homestead, paddling a flatboat. The waters of the Sangamom washed him into New Salem, a frontier village with some 20 cabins and 100 inhabitants. First a farm hand, then a railsplitter, volunteer soldier, storekeeper, surveyor, and finally the village postmaster in 1836 he did whatever came his way. His ability as a storyteller, his native wit and kindness, won him devoted friends.
- (5) In 1832, he ran for the Illinois State Assembly but lost. In 1834, however, he won and was subsequently re-elected to the Assembly three times. He took part in debates and developed his skill as a speaker. His deepest attachment in New Salem was said to have been Ann Rutledge, a lovely auburn-haired girl of 18 when Lincoln first met her. But malaria came to New Salem in 1835, and Ann died of it at age 22. Despondent, Lincoln packed all his worldly goods in two saddle bags and left New Salem. He rode to Springfield, the state capital, and never returned.
- (a) Becoming a lawyer in 1837, Lincoln became a partner in a law office. Preparing cases for courts in 14 counties, he spent years as a circuit lawyer, riding on horseback from village to village across the Illinois prairies. He was out in all kinds of weather, on hazardous roads, in isolated sections, but he never forgot to consider both sides in any case and that the roots of justice were in common sense.
- (7) In 1842, at the age of 33, he married Mary Todd, a high-tempered and ambitious young woman from Lexington, Kentucky. After their marriage, Lincoln bought a frame house on Eighth Street in Springfield where he raised a family of four sons. A devoted father, a patient husband, he endured his wife's high temper and sometimes erratic behavior.

The author's desire is to present material from which the reader may form an opinion of Lincoln rather than to present opinions and judgments of his own Lincoln literature has increased amazingly in the past twenty five years Mention of the principal biographies in existence at the time of the original edition was included in the Preface Since then there have appeared among the more formal biographies the comprehensive and authoritative work by Nicolay and Hay the subsequent work by Miss Ida Tarbell and that by Herndon and Weik besides many more or less fragmentary publications Some additions but not many have been made to the present edition from these sources The recently published Diary of Gideon Welles one of the most valuable commentaries on the Civil War period now available has provided some material of exceptional interest concerning Lincoln's relations with the members of his Cabinet In re writing the present work it has been compressed into about two thirds of its former compass to render it more popular both in form and in price and to give it in some places a greater measure of coherency and continuity as an outline narrative of the Civil War Abraham Lincoln Stephen B.
