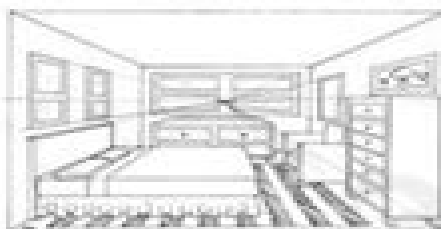

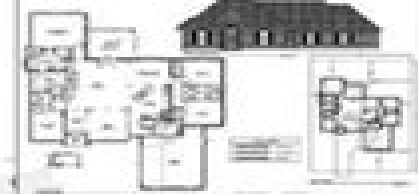

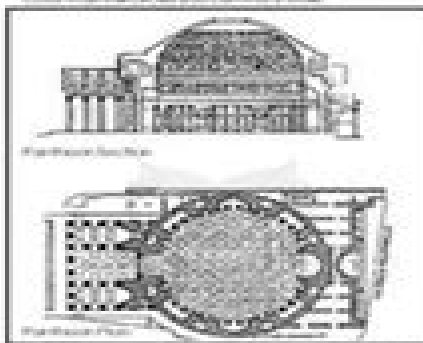

Pantheon Shapes

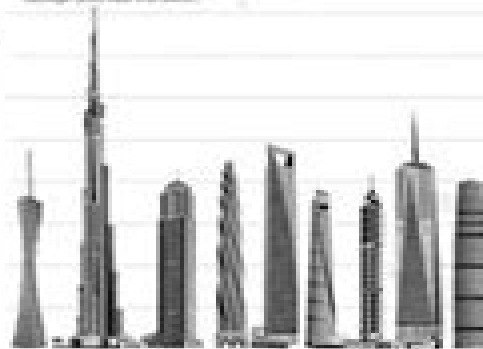
The Pantheon in Rome was built to honor the gods.
