the increased hostility of receiving states is examined in light of their human rights obligations Consideration is paid to how Africans navigate their post migration lives which includes reconciling themselves to status fracture taking on jobs for which they are over qualified while simultaneously dealing with the resentment borne of status threat on the part of the citizenry Part two moves from the general to consider the intersections of gender and status focusing on women LGBTI individuals and children Focusing on their human rights and the fictional literature chapter four looks at women who have been trafficked as well as domestic workers and hotel maids while chapter five is on LGBTI people whose legal and literary stories are only now being told The final substantive chapter considers the experiences of children who may arrive as unaccompanied minors Using a mixture of poetry and first person accounts the chapter examines the post arrival lives of children some of whom may be citizens but who are continually made to feel like outsiders.
