Located thousands of miles away from the country's power centers on the east coast at the time the announcement came a month before the Mexican American War had ended and among the very few Americans that were near the region at the time many of them were Army soldiers who were participating in the war and garrisoned there. San Francisco was still best known for being a Spanish military and missionary outpost during the colonial era and only a few hundred called it home. Mexico's independence and its possession of those lands had come only a generation earlier. Everything changed almost literally overnight. While the Mexican American War technically concluded with a treaty in February 1848, the announcement brought an influx of an estimated 90,000 Forty Niners to the region in 1849, hailing from other parts of America and even as far away as Asia.
