

# NCAA Rule Changes



The new rules added a four-day recruiting period (Monday through Thursday) in April and also the opportunity for coaches to attend the NBA Players Association Top 100 camp in mid-June.

High school players will be allowed more official visits as soon as Aug. 1 the summer before their junior year in high school.



University presidents and chancellors will be held personally accountable for their athletics program.

Those who break rules face stronger penalties including longer postseason bans, longer head coach suspensions, increase recruiting restrictions and additional fines.



The creation of independent groups to prevent conflicts of interest.

Public members not affiliated with the NCAA or member schools will join the NCAA Board of Governors to bring new perspective and independent judgment. The change to the board composition is effective Aug. 1, 2019 pending the adoption of at the 2019 NCAA Convention.
