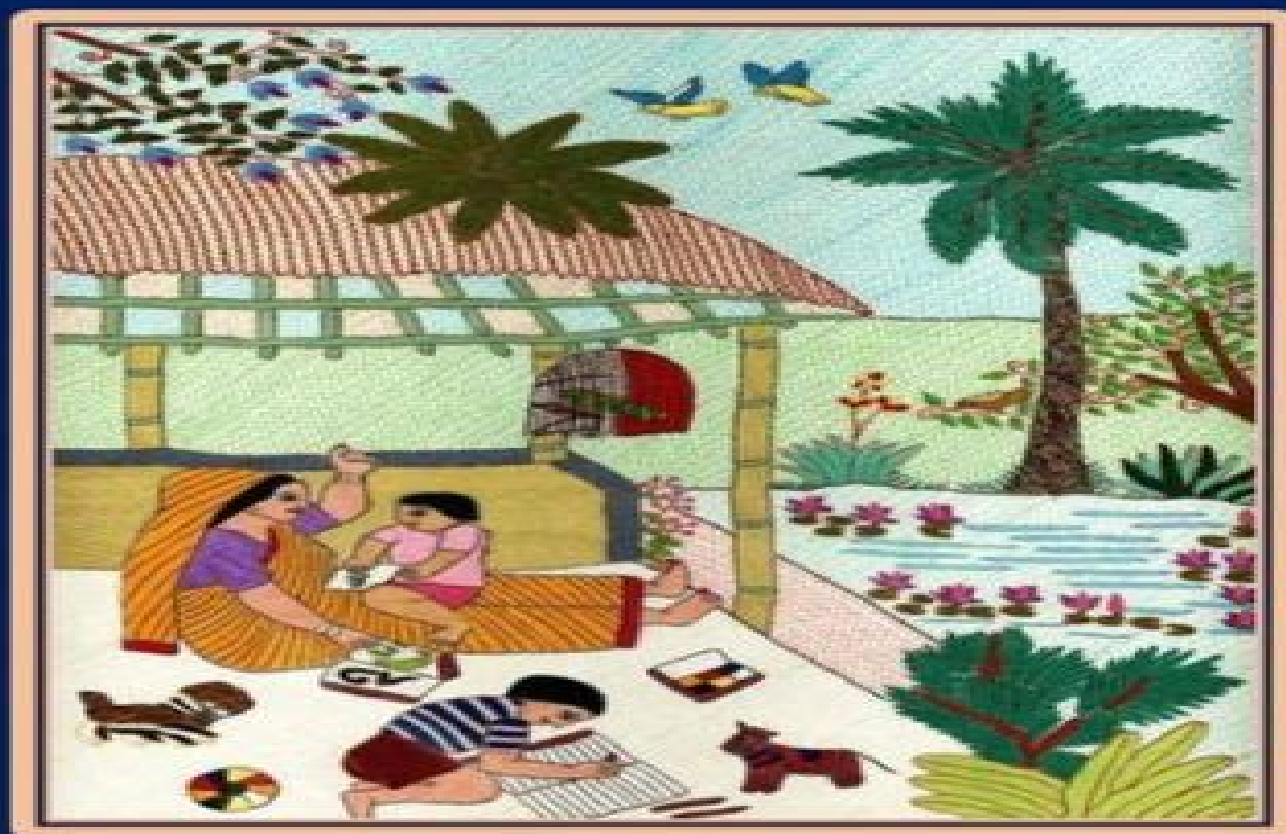

A Brief History Of Bengal For Diaspora Bangladeshis:

The Bengal Diaspora Claire Alexander, Joya Chatterji, Annu Jalais, 2015-11-06 India's partition in 1947 and the creation of Bangladesh in 1971 saw the displacement and resettling of millions of Muslims and Hindus resulting in profound transformations across the region. A third of the region's population sought shelter across new borders almost all of them resettling in the Bengal delta itself. A similar number were internally displaced while others moved to the Middle East, North America and Europe. Using a creative interdisciplinary approach combining historical, sociological and anthropological approaches to migration and diaspora, this book explores the experiences of Bengali Muslim migrants through this period of upheaval and transformation. It draws on over 200 interviews conducted in Britain, India and Bangladesh tracing migration and settlement within and from the Bengal delta region in the period after 1947. Focussing on migration and diaspora from below, it teases out fascinating hidden migrant stories including those of women refugees and displaced people. It reveals surprising similarities and important differences in the experience of Muslim migrants in widely different contexts and places whether in the towns and hamlets of Bengal delta or in the cities of Britain. Counter posing accounts of the structures that frame migration with the textures of how migrants shape their own movement, it examines what it means to make new homes in a context of diaspora. The book is also unique in its focus on the experiences of those who stayed behind and in its analysis of ruptures in the migration process. Importantly, the book seeks to challenge crude attitudes to Muslim migrants which assume their cultural and religious homogeneity and to humanize contemporary discourses around global migration.
